Eta Sigma Alpha shall encourage the development of an intellectual climate that will stimulate the exchange of ideas and ideals, foster scholarship, and promote academic excellence. Eta Sigma Alpha shall also advocate homeschooling as a viable and successful educational methodology and act as a liaison for homeschooling to the general public, colleges/universities, and the media."

Sponsored by the Home Education Partnership of Texas, the Alpha Chapter was started in 1999 and is the charter chapter. The Alpha Chapter is available to students who are homeschooled and who meet the academic requirements of the honor society.

Students may apply as early as the end of the spring semester of their 6th grade year. High school seniors' applications will not be accepted after the October of their senior year. Formal induction will be at the annual ESA Banquet held each spring by the Alpha Chapter.

Membership in Eta Sigma Alpha National Home School Honor Society is an opportunity for home school scholars to be rewarded for their academic successes. We hope that you will choose to apply for this honor.

Membership Guidelines

Application Requirements

- Student must be homeschooled. 51% of the homeschooling must be supervised by the parent.
- Applications may be submitted at the end of the spring semester of the student's 6th grade year through October of his/her 12th grade year, for membership during 7th – 12th grades.
- Applicant must have a 3.5 grade point average on a 4-point scale and must supply a transcript with his/her application.
- Applicant must provide proof of test scores from one of the following tests: Stanford or IOWA (90% composite score), PSAT 8/9/10/NMSQT (1200), SAT (1200), ACT (26), or CLT (88). Parent may NOT administer the test or be present during the test/on-line test.
- Applicant must submit a short statement about why he/she would like to be a member of Eta Sigma Alpha.
- As a reference for recommendation, an applicant must submit the name and address of the HEP instructor if enrolled in HEP classes.
- Applicant's parents must submit a letter of recommendation for their student/child.
- Applicant must submit a list of three (or four if not an HEP student) additional names and addresses of individuals and would be willing to provide a recommendation on their behalf.
- Applicant must complete and submit an application form.
